Family Size	Monthly gross income limit	Yearly gross income limit
1	\$1,073	\$12,880
2	\$1,452	\$17,420
3	\$1,830	\$21,960
4	\$2,208	\$26,500
5	\$2,587	\$31,040
6	\$2,965	\$35,580
7	\$3,343	\$40,120
8	\$3,722	\$44,660

Add \$4,450/year to income eligibility limit for each family member over 8 members.
